Calling all motorcycle riders. Prep your bikes now for the 10th annual Veteran's Day Lab Ride to take place at noon on Thursday, Nov. 7.

This year donations will support the Alameda Community County Food Bank and Operation S.A.M. Alameda County Community Food Bank is the hub of a vast collection and distribution network that provides food for 275 nonprofit agencies in Alameda County and distributes enough food for 380,000 meals weekly.

Operation S.A.M. is a non-profit organization that sends packages to troops deployed all over the world to show support and appreciation for the men and women who are unselfishly placing themselves in harm's way.

The money collected from this year's ride will be split 50/50 in support of these two organizations. A minimum of \$20 per person is requested, but additional dollar donations would be appreciated by both organizations. The first 100 riders will get a special 'Ride' commemorative pin for participating.

Employees will stage at Outer Loop Road, east of Bldg. 671, and non-employees may meet at the Discovery Center parking lot off of Greenville and East Gate. Motorcyclists will ride together from LLNL to Site 300.
