The 10th annual Veteran's Day Lab Ride brought 64 motorcycles and 80 people out last week to join in the leisurely ride from LLNL to Site 300.

After the ride, the Alameda County Firefighters Association hosted a BBQ lunch for participants. \$1,600 was raised to support the Alameda County Community Food Bank and Operation S.A.M.

The Alameda County Community Food Bank is the hub of a vast collection and distribution network that provides food for 275 nonprofit agencies in Alameda County and distributes enough food for 380,000 meals weekly.

Operation S.A.M. is a non-profit organization that sends packages to the troops deployed all over the world to show support and appreciation for the men and women who are unselfishly placing themselves in harm's way.
