TULUM MAYAN RUINS - PCM403

The impressive cliff-top site of Tulum is one of the most famous landmarks of the Mayan world. Board your motor coach for a one hour drive south to Tulum. During the journey, your guide will share a narrative on the area and Mayan culture. Once at Tulum, enjoy a guided tour of this walled city, its temples and buildings. Its cliff-top location gives the site a special atmosphere as well as great views! After the tour, you'll have time to walk around and enjoy the spectacular views of the beautiful beach, overlooked by the temple. Note: There is a \$5-7 USD fee for the use of video cameras in Tulum. A boxed lunch will be provided. Complimentary water or soft drinks are included. This tour may include a short shopping stop on the return to your ship. Guide books are available for purchase at the Shore Excursions Desk. All guests on this tour will have a ferry ride of approximately 40 minutes from Playa Del Carmen to Cozumel.

FAT CAT SAILING CATAMARAN ADVENTURE – PCM410 Approximate Duration: 4 ½ hours

Board a luxury, custom-designed catamaran to explore the Riviera Mayan coastline. Sailing north for approximately one hour, head to the crescent bay of Bahia Inha to snorkel at some of the best coral reefs in the area. On the return journey, try the famous "Boom Net", a huge net that drags at the rear of the Cat at 12 knots, forming a natural Jacuzzi in the ocean. Chilling out on deck with a cold beer is also a favorite activity, as well as sport fishing. Note: Drinks, snacks, fruit platters and snorkel equipment are all included.

FORMULA ONE OFFSHORE ADVENTURE – PCM426 Approximate Duration: 4 ½ hours Level 2/Meal/ Weight

At Puerto Aventuras Marina you'll receive a safety briefing and head out for an exciting offshore powerboat race to Tulum, where you'll anchor to swim and view the famous ruins from the ocean. This state-of-the-art offshore powerboat provides an unforgettably exciting, fast, and safe ride. Enjoy a relaxing lunch and drinks, at a charming Mexican restaurant and some beach time. Back onboard, hang on for second leg of the offshore race back to the marina, where the winning boat team enjoys victory champagne and photos. Note: Participants must weigh no more than 300 lbs. Wear your bathing suit and bring a towel. This tour is not recommended for persons with heart conditions and prone to severe seasickness. Swimming and snorkeling stops will be made.

XEL-HA NATURAL AQUARIUM – PCM406

In this natural lagoon, you'll experience some fabulous snorkeling and view an amazing variety of marine life. This lagoon was sacred to the Mayans, and today it is a major attraction for snorkeling due to the clarity of the lucid waters. Xel-Ha offers a collection of coves, caves, inlets and lagoons. You can rent snorkel equipment or take a refreshing swim, walk the jungle paths or relax in a lounge chair. Note: Participants should be extra cautious, as the park grounds consist of uneven limestone and natural stone steps.

MAYAN ZIPLINE & BIKE ADVENTURE – PCM433 Approximate Duration: 6 hours Level 2/Meal/Age/ Weight

Take the ferry ride to Playa del Carmen, and be transported to one of the most magical sites in the Yucatan Peninsula - Chikin-Ha. Ride your bike through jungle paths passing Mayan-style mini-plantations. Explore an extraordinary system of Cenotes as you swim and snorkel in their crystalline waters. Zip line from one Cenote to another, harnessed to cables that allow for three exhilarating flights of up to 200 feet. The zip lines are a series of cables strung among the tree tops of dense jungle areas. Observe and participate in a traditional Mayan purification ceremony, performed by a genuine Mayan Shaman. Once back in Playa del Carmen, you will have time to shop. Note: Participants must be at least 8 years of age, in good physical condition and weigh no more than 250 lbs. Wear your bathing suit and bring a towel. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women or those with back or heart problems. Meal will be at a site to enjoy a sampling of Yucatan cuisine and hospitality.

XCARET - PCM401

Approximate Duration: 7 hours Xcaret is a beautiful eco-archeological theme park that offers a naturally tropical exploration of the Caribbean jungle. Once you enter the park, you're on your own to explore and experience the beauty of nature. This theme park offers a museum, a bird sanctuary, stables, botanical gardens, restored Mayan ruins, a replicated Mayan village, beautiful beaches and natural pools. Enjoy a snorkeling experience through the mysterious underground river and swim with the friendly dolphins. The dolphin tour carries an extra charge and operates on a first-come, first-served basis (reservations are not available). Note: Food and refreshments are available at the park for an additional fee.

CANCUN HIGHLIGHTS, BEACH & SHOPPING–PCM409 Approximate Duration: 6 hours

Discover Cancun, its history, beaches and shopping! Your guide provides a narrative on what was once a tiny fishing village 30 years ago that has since grown into the most famous resort area today. Your first stop is at Mirador, where you will enjoy a unique view of Cancun's ocean front. Continue past the scenic coast dotted with restaurants, hotels and luxury villas. Your next destination is a local shopping plaza, where you can shop and bargain with local artisans, walk the beach, or sample a Mexican lunch in a local restaurant, at your own expense. Note: Complimentary soft drinks on the bus are included. Wear your bathing suit and bring a towel.

MYSTIC CAVERNS & BEACH ESCAPE – PCM429

As your tender arrives at Playa del Carmen, you will board your air-conditioned motor coach. At Aktun Chen, your guide will escort you through the underground world to view the incredible stalagmites and stalactites. Learn the fascinating history of this ancient sacred place still used by Mayans today for purification of body and spirit. After touring the cavern, the turquoise waters of the Mayan Riviera await you. Enjoy a delicious buffet lunch, swim in the aqua blue water, walk along the white sand, soak up some sun or just relax in an umbrella covered lounge chair. Note: Participants must be at least 6 years of age. Wear your bathing suit; bring a towel and bug spray.

MAYAN TRAILS & HIDDEN TEMPLES – PCM430

Level 2/Meal Approximate Duration: 8 hours Explore both the beautiful Sian Kaan biosphere with its variety of wildlife and jungle paths and the ruins of the ancient Mayan city of Muyil! After a scenic and informative drive, you will arrive at your destination. At the ruins, you will discover the 56-foot high pyramid, El Castillo and other partially excavated structures still semi-covered in jungle growth. A bridged path leads you through part of the Sian Kaan Biosphere that is home to dense vegetation, Chicle gum trees and various plants used for medicinal purposes. The path leads you to the Muyil fresh water lagoon - once used by the Mayans as a trade route to the Caribbean. Note: We recommend you bring bug spray. There is a government tax of \$5-8 US on the use of video cameras. A boxed lunch is included.
