Elsehul has a remarkable array of wildlife including black-browed albatross, grey-headed albatross, light-mantled sooty albatross, king, macaroni and gentoo penguins, blue-eyed shags, southern elephant seals and fur seals.</p> <p>Disembarkation Sequence:</p> <p>1) Albatross 2) Penguin 3) Seal 4) Whale</p>

TBA	<p>We hope to land at Salisbury Plain</p> <p>Weather permitting we hope to land by zodiac at Salisbury Plain. The king penguin colony is approximately a 800 m (0.5 mi) walk from the landing site. There will be thousands of king penguins and fur seals on beach so please watch where you walk.
